### Transcript

I'm **Isa Arslanoski**, I'm from Perth Western Australia, here in Doha, Qatar. I'm on this magnificent project called the "Pearl GTL Project". A bit of background on myself: I'm married, I have four children, I have a grandson - a 19 month baby. During the day this is very busy, very busy; traffic, people working everywhere. During the night, when I come out to have a look around, it's terrific - the lighting, people working. There's large vessels, there's large construction areas here. It's terrific; they're like scary monsters in a dream. We've got a village, it's not a camp, it's a village... and it's just busy, busy as....
