Who are we?

With almost 18,000 members, Shell Pensioners Association exists to provide a range of services to pensioners, deferred pensioners and their partners. Life membership costs a **one-off** payment of £5!

What do I get?

- A **free quarterly magazine** covering financial and pension matters, the annual pension increase, developments in Shell, social events and news of retired staff
- **Preferential rates and discounts**, on various products and services such as insurance and membership to national organisations
- A **website with information**, useful contacts and a chance to link up with ex-colleagues
- A small team in Shell Centre who will be pleased to **help deal with your queries**
- The services of an **independent consultant** on state benefits
- 24 branches across England, Scotland and Wales, which organise a variety of **social functions**, operating on a non-profit basis
- Eligibility for one-off **assistance from the Shell Pensioners Benevolent Association**, if in need of assistance.

How does it work?

There is a part-time Secretary and Assistant, based in Shell Centre, reporting to an elected National Committee. The SPA maintain an effective relationship with Shell and will keep you informed on pension matters. We regularly meet with senior management of Shell, including the UK Chairman, to ensure pensioners' needs and views are understood.

Should I join a branch?

If you wish to play a more active part in SPA, you may join one or more branches at any time and enjoy social events such as lunches, walks, talks, theatre visits. There is usually a nominal fee to cover costs.

Branch chairmen meet once a year to discuss items of national interest and have the opportunity to discuss issues with senior management.

Financial support

The Shell Pensioners Benevolent Association (SPBA) is a charity to support SPA members in case of distress. Every year they award about £150,000 in grants and make interest-free loans. Cases of hardship are usually identified via the Pensioner Liaison Representatives. SPBA relies on donations from members.

Can I become a member?

Membership is open to anyone who receives a pension from Shell Contributory Pension Fund (SCPF), Shell Overseas Contributory Pension Fund (SOCPF), members of other Shell pension funds or those who have left but not yet taken their pension (deferred pensioners). On death of a member, membership transfers to the partner, at no cost.
