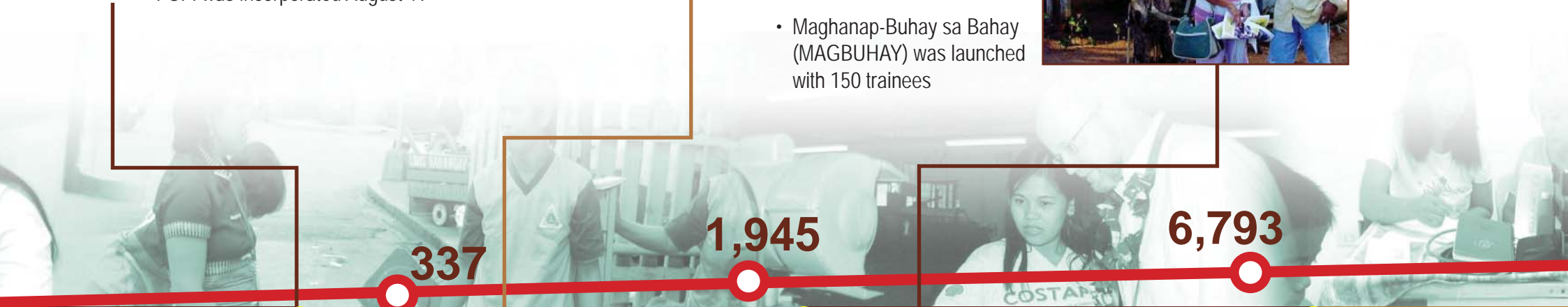
PSFI was incorporated August 19

SKP was launched with 164 trainees

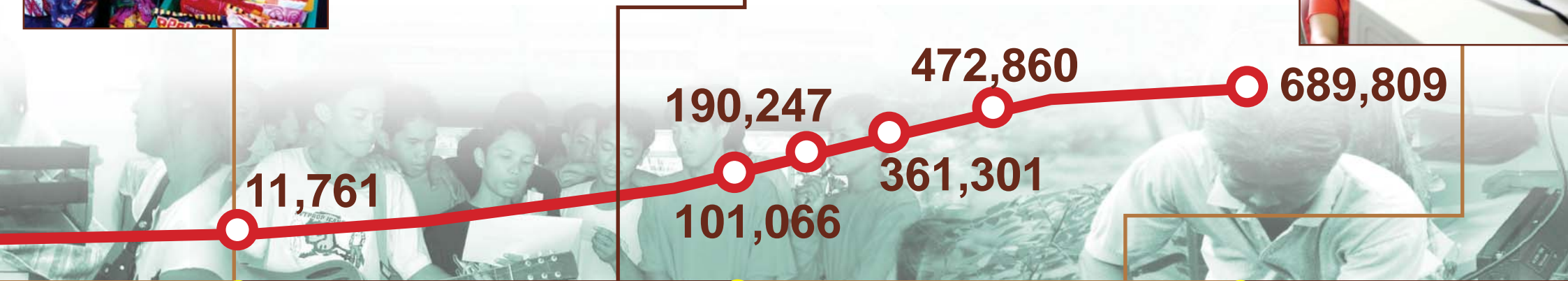


- Suporta sa Buhay (SUHAY), a microcredit program, was launched

1998

- Kilusan Ligtas Malaria (KLM), a malaria control program, was launched in Palawan
- PSFI expands operations in Batangas, Mindoro, and Palawan



2003



- Lingap sa Kalusugan ng Palawan was launched
- Community Skills Training and Accreditation Program (COSTAPRO) was launched
- Sitio Agusuhin, Subic was turned over to Local Government Unit

2006

- PSFI was named Principal Recipient of a US\$14.3Mn grant from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis, and Malaria to implement malaria control measures in 5 provinces – Palawan, Apayao, Quirino, Tawi-tawi, and Sulu
- PSFI launched Social Development Program for Tagbilaran, Bohol
- SKIL was expanded to include electronic SKIL, a skills training in information and communications technologies.
